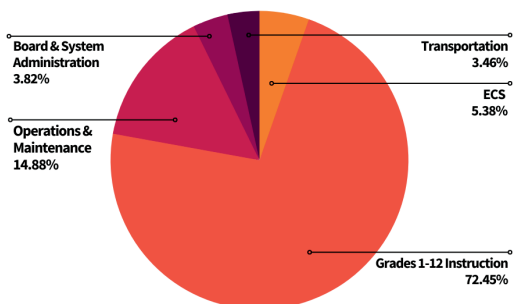

Fiscal Stewardship

Our finances must always reflect our values. To support excellence in learning and ensure that all students receive the opportunities to become the persons God created them to be, financial allocations must support a maximum allotment of dollars to the classroom and equity in the distribution of these dollars.

The 2021/2022 actual operating expenditures for the school division were \$63,303,707. Of this total, over 77% was focused on ECS to Grade 12 instruction:

Priorities and Successes



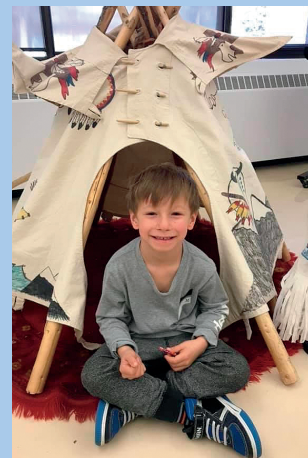
Priority 1: Staff and students will grow in their faith and experience the richness of Catholic Education.

As a Catholic school division it is essential that we live our faith publicly and serve as role models to our students and communities. Some of the results that we are most proud of:

- 97% of staff felt that the Faith Plan Theme, *Transformed by the Journey*, and corresponding calls to action inspired and helped them to grow in their own faith
- 94% of students agreed that their school is a Catholic community that helps them to understand their Catholic faith
- 95% of students felt encouraged and given the opportunity to actively live their faith in the school and in the community

Priority 3: First Nations, Métis, and Inuit education for all.

Our Graduation Coaches, First Nations, Métis and Inuit Support Workers, and other administrators and staff, continue to build strong relationships and support our First Nations, Métis and Inuit students. This work continues to yield strong long-term results.

We continue to prioritize enhancing staff and student understanding of First Nations, Métis, and Inuit ways of knowing, being, and doing, as well as the application of foundational knowledge by faculty and staff to the benefit of all students.

Priority 2: High quality instruction rooted in sound research and effective assessment practices to support growth for all learners.

Despite the learning interruptions from the COVID-19 pandemic, our staff continues to recognize the importance of foundational skills and provide multiple opportunities for rigorous and relevant learning experiences.
