Supportive Programming for Diverse Learners

Divisional Intervention Support Team

- Using research-based strategies, the Intervention Support Team works with classroom teachers to implement programs that will enhance learning opportunities for all students.

English as an Additional Language (EAL)

- Providing support for Kindergarten to Grade 12 English language learners in the division, our EAL Coordinator collaborates with our divisional English Language Learning Team and classroom teachers to identify and implement effective instructional supports.
- As part of the intake process, the EAL Coordinator meets new, incoming English language learners and their families to facilitate a smooth transition to school.

Family First Facilitator (FFF) Program

- Through the provision of a prevention and early intervention model, the FFF supports children, youth, and families in acquiring skills and knowledge required to strengthen and increase their capacity to care for themselves and others. This dynamic program is delivered in École St. Mary and The Children of St. Martha schools.

Family School Liaison Counsellor (FSLC) Program

- The FSLC Program utilizes a proactive approach to deliver services to children, youth, and families. Program services include counselling, prevention/educational programming, community liaison, and crisis intervention. Highly skilled FSLCs work within the school environment and are available to any family with students attending Holy Spirit Catholic School Division.

Mental Health Capacity Building (MHCB) Program

- The MHCB Program works to promote positive mental health in children, youth, and families in the communities where they live. The program is based on the belief that mental and emotional wellbeing can be developed, nurtured, and supported through promotion and prevention efforts. This vibrant team delivers service throughout the school division.

Student Wellness Access Guides

- The Mental Health in Schools Pilot Project supports the work of two Student Wellness Access Guides, who aim to bridge connection and sustainability by assessing, planning, and collaborating to support students in navigating and developing pathways to and from universal, targeted, and individualized support through multi-faceted approaches.



French Language Instruction

French as a Second Language (FSL)

FSL is offered in most schools from Grades 4 to 12. Students enjoy learning basic French skills and appreciate various traditional celebrations closely linked to our Catholic faith and Francophone cultures, such as: la Toussaint, Carnaval, l'Épiphanie, and la Chandeleur.

French Immersion

The French Immersion program is offered across Canada and is designed for children whose parents do not speak French. In this program, students learn most of their subjects in French, which enables them to become functionally fluent in the language. French Immersion is offered in Early Learning to Grade 12 at École St. Mary, St. Francis Junior High, and Catholic Central High School. St. Michael's School (Pincher Creek) offers French infused Kindergarten classes, French Immersion from Grades 1 to 6, and French Language Arts for Grades 7 and 8.

Cultural activities, the DELF proficiency exams, exchange opportunities, and school trips are offered to both FSL and French Immersion students who pursue second language learning at the junior and senior high levels.

Early Learning Program

Early Learning Programming is offered to children 3 and 4 years of age by December 31st. We believe that:

- Play is the work of children. It is through play and interaction with others that children develop the ability to regulate their emotions and their thinking.
- By focusing on learning through play, we encourage children to interact, explore, create, solve problems, and make sense of the world around them.
- Our nurturing environment assists children in their development of positive relationships and problem-solving skills through daily interaction with peers and adults.
- Parents are the first and most important teachers in their child's life. As such, they are valued partners in the Early Learning experience.

There is fully-funded Early Intervention Programming for children with exceptional learning needs, as well as coordinated community services to meet the needs of the children and their families.

Kindergarten

Kindergarten is offered to children 5 years of age by December 31st. We believe that:

- Children develop at different rates. Kindergarten provides learning experiences that meet individual needs.
- Young children are naturally curious and eager to learn. They benefit from developing positive relationships with others, including children their own age.
- Through play, exploration, and learning centres, children develop spiritually, physically, intellectually, emotionally, and socially.
- Parents are the first and most important teachers of their children.



First Nations, Métis, and Inuit Education

- We are committed to living truth and reconciliation in Holy Spirit Catholic School Division.
- We support our First Nations, Métis, and Inuit students through our team of First Nations, Métis, and Inuit Support Workers, as well as our three Graduation Coach Programs called:

"Oohkaanaayikaakii'moap," (We are all striving for success)

Based at Catholic Central High, St. Francis Junior High, and St. Michael's School (Pincher Creek), our Graduation Coaches work with students to create a path for success in school. Student success is celebrated at our school awards ceremonies, family and student gatherings, and Feather Blessings.

- We foster reconciliation through listening, accompaniment, and recognition of the ongoing impacts of the past. We are actively creating partnerships and relationships with local organizations to respond to the Calls to Action of the Truth and Reconciliation Commission of Canada. We are continually seeking ways to increase and enhance opportunities for staff and students to connect with local Elders and knowledge keepers to learn together.
- We are deepening our understanding of our collective responsibilities as Treaty People. We support a variety of courses and co-curricular clubs including Blackfoot courses, language and cultural programs, beading, dance, and drumming groups. Ongoing staff development and professional learning is offered to meaningfully infuse First Nations, Métis, and Inuit culture, history, traditions, and worldviews into curricular programming.
